Calvin is the recipient of a governor general award for his work in health and he became a Certified First Nations Health Manager with the First Nations Health Manager Association of Canada. Mr. Morrisseau believes that he can bring his wealth of knowledge and experience to the Board of Directors, especially having worked and walked in the Indigenous and Non-Indigenous world. He firmly believes that seniors and elders deserve to be empowered and respected for all their years of experience.
